It's YOUR locker But there are a few rules you have to follow.

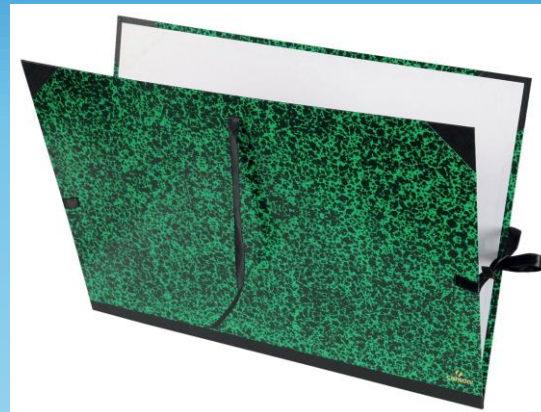


# Keep your locker clean, and don't overstuff it.

Be careful with large objects, such as:



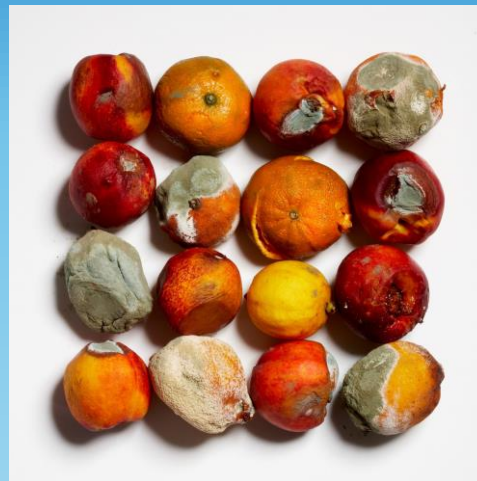
# Do not leave food in your locker.

## Any breach of these few rules:

- Keeping the security deposit
